### UNDERSTANDING NORMAL BREAST BIOLOGY

The Peachey Fund has made a commitment for up to \$75,000 for the creation of the Guiding Breast Cancer Management Through Understanding Normal Breast Biology program at the I.U. Simon Comprehensive Cancer Center.

Our contribution will help initiate the program and bolster requests for additional institutional support.



### APPLICATION OF EMERGING PROTEOMICS TECHNOLOGIES TO BREAST CANCER

\$20,000 gift from the Peachey Fund: Led by Amber Mosley, Ph.D., this research team would like to determine if an innovative molecular tool called thermal proteome profiling can help observe and characterize the changes that occur as a cell moves from normal to cancerous to evading treatment and possibly metastasizing. Potentially answering the question of why some breast cancer cells survive after treatment.
